This period is limited to five (5) speakers with a time limit of three (3) minutes per speaker.

Agenda Items: Kindly submit a "Public Comment Form" stating which item(s) on the agenda you wish to speak to fifteen (15) minutes before the start of the scheduled meeting time with the Brownsville Communication and Marketing Department staff. Speakers will be allowed to address the Arts and Culture Task Force on the agenda item before it is to be considered. The speaker is limited to three (3) minutes.


Time Limits: The Arts and Culture Task Force shall have the discretion to modify its regulations regarding time limits on public comment if necessary. For example, the time limit may be shortened to accommodate a lengthy agenda or it could be lengthened to allow additional time for discussion on a complicated matter or if there is a need for an interpreter.
