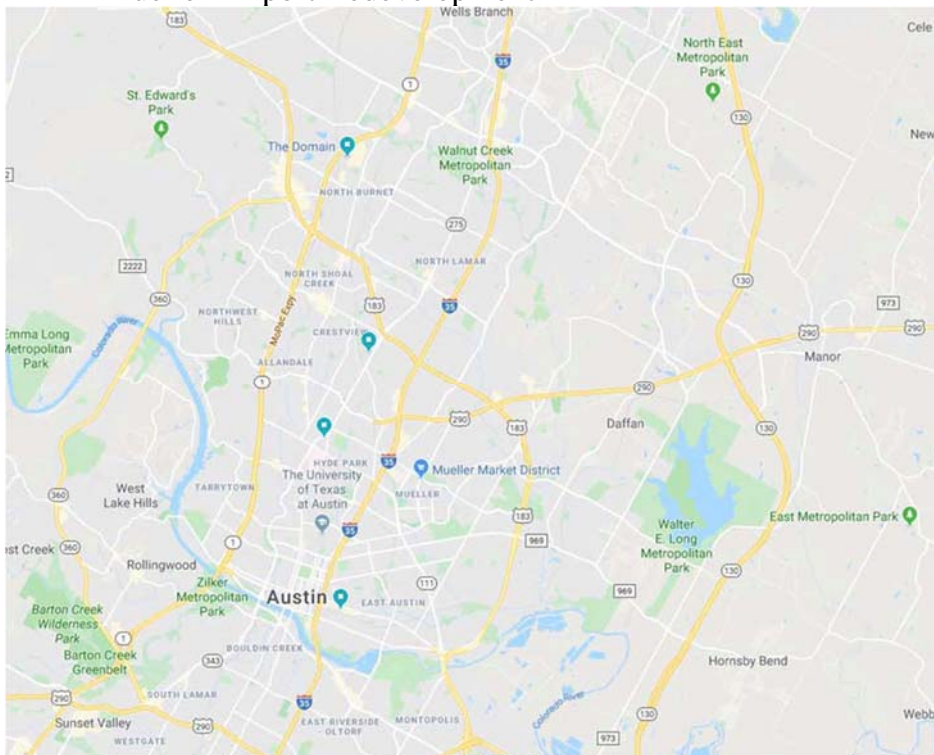
S. Lamar between Juliet Street and 1500 S. Lamar Street
