

**NOTICE OF A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION
TO BE HELD BY THE CITY OF BROWNSVILLE, TEXAS**

TIME AND PURPOSE OF ELECTION: The City of Brownsville, Texas (the "City") will hold a General Municipal Election between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 7:00 P.M. on Saturday, May 04, 2019, in the City to fill the vacancies resulting from the expiration of the terms of office for **Mayor, At-Large Commissioner "A", District Commissioner 1, and District Commissioner 2.**

PLACE OF ELECTION: For the purpose of holding said election, the City is divided into fifty-six (56) election precincts. Such election precincts have numbers and boundaries identical to those of the corresponding Cameron County election precincts, except that the boundaries of the City election precincts exclude areas outside the City. The polling places for the City election precincts are consolidated into the following eighteen (18) locations, which are grouped by the four (4) City Electoral Districts:
