



## Public Notice

The City of Brownsville Transportation Department, Brownsville Metro administers the Federal Transit Administration Full Apportionment **Fiscal Year 2019 Enhanced Mobility of Seniors & Individuals with Disabilities – Section 5310** for the urbanized area of Brownsville, Texas. The goal of the program is to improve mobility for seniors and individuals with disabilities throughout the country, removing barriers to transportation services and expanding the transportation mobility options available.

Brownsville Metro is now accepting applications from organizations (State or local governmental authority, a private non-profit organization, or an operator of public transportation that receives a Section 5310 grant indirectly through a recipient) who wish to apply for grant funds for capital and operating expenses for approved projects. It is a competitive grant process. If an application is selected and FTA approves the grant; afterwards, the successful applicant will enter into an agreement with Brownsville Metro. Please review all contents of the Section 5310 web site at <http://bmetro.cob.us>

If no grant(s) application(s) are received or if there are no successful applicant(s), then the following draft of Brownsville Metro's 5310 expenditures shall apply and Brownsville Metro self-certifies that they can successfully meet and exceed the requirements of the 5310 Grant Program.

In the event Brownsville Metro self-certifies, the proposed draft expenditures shall become the final notice for expenditures under the Fiscal Year 2019 Full Funding 5310 Grant program.
