Tuesday, March 17, 2020 – As a precaution to help limit the spread of coronavirus (COVID-19), the Brownsville Public Library System will be temporarily closing both the Southmost and Main Branch Libraries until further notice. All services will be suspended, due dates for checked out items will be extended and fines will not accrue during this time. This suspension includes all public programs, events and room rentals.
